Application Checklist

For more information about each of the items listed below, please visit the website (www.digipen.edu/prospective-students) or refer to the Application section in the course catalog.

Applicants to all undergraduate degree programs must submit:

- Application fee of US \$35.00. If an applicant is denied admission to the program, then the application fee will be refunded.
- Official high school transcripts or Official GED test scores. Transcripts must be SEALED and may be included or requested from the high school to be sent directly to DigiPen. Accepted applicants will be asked to provide a copy of their final high school transcript or other proof of completion of graduation requirements before beginning classes. If you earned your GED, please also submit transcripts for anytime that you spent at your high school.
- Official SAT I or ACT exam scores. Although DigiPen does not have a minimum score used for admissions, these standardized tests are required in the application evaluation process. DigiPen does not require the writing portion of the SAT exam, but will take those scores into consideration during evaluation. The reporting codes for DigiPen are: SAT-4138; ACT-6659. (Please note: applicants who have already graduated from high school and have one year of previous college experience are exempt from submitting ACT/SAT scores. This does not include Running Start or other high school concurrent programs.)
- Official college transcripts. College and university transcripts must be SENT DIRECTLY by the issuing institution or sent in a SEALED envelope with an official stamp across the seal.
- **Personal Statement.** Create a response to 3 short essay topics. These topics are detailed on our website. These responses allow DigiPen to gain gain insight about you that is not readily apparent in your other materials.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation (optional but highly recommended.) Letters of recommendation MUST be from individuals familiar with your academic background and/or work ethic, i.e. an instructor, guidance counselor or employer. Recommendation letters from family members will not be considered. Each letter MUST be sealed, signed and dated by the author and must contain a contact phone number. Please use the recommendation letter templates, which you may download from https://management.digipen.edu/srs-app/ or contact the Office of Admissions for copies to be sent to you.
- Other official documentation (if applicable.) This includes, but is not limited to: copy of the permanent resident card, TOEFL scores (reporting code for DigiPen 4138), and a financial responsibility form (please download from www.digipen.edu) for international students, etc.

Important Information for International Students

If you are a foreign resident, but have fulfilled any one of the following conditions, you may qualify for U.S. resident tuition rates:

- 1. Resided in Washington State for three (3) years immediately prior to receiving a high school diploma, and completed the full senior year at a Washington high school;
- **OR** 2. Completed the equivalent of a high school diploma and resided in Washington State for the three (3) years immediately before receiving the equivalent of the diploma;
- **OR** 3. Continuously resided in the State since earning the high school diploma or its equivalent.

Additional materials for specific degree programs

Art Portfolio - Required for B.F.A. and B.A. in Game Design applicants only.

Game Modification Analysis - Required for Game Design (B.S. and B.A.) applicants only.

Character/Environment Analysis - Required for B.S. in Game Design applicants only.

Math Requirement - All B.S. applicants will need to have completed math up thru pre-calculus to be eligible for admission. Applicants that are in the midst of completing pre-calculus may have their applications evaluated based on their first quarter/semester grades. DigiPen generally looks for a B average or better in all math classes.

Optional Materials allowed for consideration.

- B.A. in Game Design Character Analysis or sketches of level designs
- B.S. in Game Design Sketches of level designs, photos of landscape and urban environments that inspire you, drawings, or other sketches.
